

# Conditions of participation

## Who organises the competition, who can participate and how are these terms and conditions accepted?

- 1) The organiser of the competition is TRIFOLIUM GASTRO & EVENT KIG, Kohlenberg 8, 4051 Basle (hereinafter referred to as the "organiser"). The competition is carried out on the basis of these conditions of participation. The organiser is in charge and responsible for the organisation, processing as well as the provision or the transfer of the prize.
- 2) Eligible for participation are natural persons from the age of 18 years. Participants are hereinafter referred to as "participants". All employees of "Crêperie" and all persons who are related with the organisation and the handling of the competition are excluded from the participation.
- 3) These conditions of participation are accepted without reservation by participating in the competition (insertion of a completed competition ticket into the competition casket or registration on the website [www.creperie-gewinnspiel.ch](http://www.creperie-gewinnspiel.ch)).

## How does the competition work, how can I participate and what is the procedure?

- 4) The organiser created an own competition crepe (hereinafter: "competition crepe") for this competition. The creation of the competition crepe was recorded on video (available here: [www.creperie-gewinnspiel.ch](http://www.creperie-gewinnspiel.ch)) and was supervised by lawyer Reto Inglin. Pictures of the competition crepe can be viewed offline (in the shop) as well as online ([www.creperie-gewinnspiel.ch](http://www.creperie-gewinnspiel.ch)). Various information about the ingredients, the decoration, the production etc. are available off- and online, which significantly facilitate the answer to the subsequent competition question.
- 5) The following competition question is asked in the sense of an estimation question:  
**What is the weight of the competition crepe (including dough, filling and decoration)?**
- 6) Anyone who wants to answer the competition question and take part in the competition will receive a competition ticket from the organiser for a fee or can buy a special competition crepe from the organiser and will receive a competition ticket as well. A competition ticket can also be purchased and

registered on the website [www.creperie-gewinnspiel.ch](http://www.creperie-gewinnspiel.ch). The contact details (name, postal address and email address) need to be stated on the ticket and the competition question has to be answered (estimated value in numbers). The fully completed competition ticket must then be inserted in the designated casket in the sales room of the organiser or registered on the aforementioned website. The number of competition tickets per participant is unlimited, which allows for multiple participations. A maximum of 350,000 competition tickets will be issued.

- 7) Competition tickets can be purchased in the period from 5<sup>th</sup> April 2018 to 9<sup>th</sup> May 2019 and inserted in the competition casket or registered on the website [www.creperie-gewinnspiel.ch](http://www.creperie-gewinnspiel.ch). After this period, the winners will be notified in writing (by post and/or email). If the winners do not contact the organiser within two weeks after the notification has been sent, the prize will be forfeited and a new winner will be determined.
- 8) The first prize will be awarded to the participant whose number stated on the competition ticket matches or is closest to the weight of the competition crepe. The participant who has the second closest number wins the second prize and so on. If two or more participants would be entitled to receive the first prize because they have stated the same number, a quiz organised by the organiser in the sales facilities will decide who receives the first prize as the sole winner. For the quiz, the organiser can decide for one or more dates and set rules for the conduct of the quiz and for any resulting delay.

### **What can be won?**

- 9) **1<sup>st</sup> prize:** The winner of the competition is entitled to take over the organiser's fully equipped creperie at Kohlenberg in the centre of Basle. This includes the take-over of the facilities, the entire inventory, the know-how, the employees as well as customers (many regular customers and tourists). The organiser and the winner will conclude a separate contract for the acquisition of all assets and liabilities of the creperie after the conclusion of the competition. Under this contract, the organiser will undertake to pay the rent for the premises until 2023 at maximum, whereby the winner of the creperie can manage it during this time without paying rent. The takeover of the creperie has to take place within half a year after the end of the competition.
- 10) **2<sup>nd</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> prize:** Those ten participants who come closest to the actual weight of the competition crepe with their numbers (estimates) after the winner of the first prize, will each win a hand-crafted porcelain rack worth about CHF 120.-.
- 11) The prizes cannot be exchanged or paid out in cash. A transfer or assignment of the prize to a third party is permitted.

### **Further conditions of participation:**

- 12) The data stated on the competition ticket will only be used for the competition and the information of the winners. Any other kind of data processing, in particular the use for other purposes or a transfer to third parties, is excluded. The data will be deleted after the winners have been determined.
- 13) The organiser has the right to exclude participants from the competition at any time without notification and justification, if they are manipulating the participation procedure or the competition or attempting to do so and/or those who are violating the rules of the competition. This also applies to participants who make false statements about themselves.
- 14) The organiser is entitled to interrupt or terminate the competition at any time without notice, communication or justification, taking into account the interests of the participants, if there is a suspicion of match-fixing and if due to technical or legal reasons a proper execution or continuation cannot be ensured.
- 15) As far as legally possible, the organiser is only liable for damages caused intentionally or grossly negligently by the organiser or one of its vicarious agents. All operating, incidental and consequential costs associated with the prize will be borne by the winners.
- 16) There will be no correspondence about the competition.
- 17) Any legal action is precluded.
- 18) The competition is subject to Swiss law.**
- 19) The organiser can change these conditions of participation at any time.
- 20) In case individual regulations within these conditions of participation be or become ineffective, the validity of the remaining regulations remains unaffected.

### **Facebook/Instagram:**

- 21) This competition is not affiliated with Facebook or Instagram and is not sponsored, supported or organised by Facebook or Instagram in any way. All questions, comments or complaints about the competition are to be directed exclusively to the organiser and not to Facebook or Instagram. The organiser and each participant release Facebook and Instagram from any claims by third parties in connection with this competition.
